Once the evaluation process of the numerous proposals received is completed and after the merger of some of them with the intention of hosting the largest number of participants in the final program, we present through this **Third Newsletter** the final list of Workshops and *Scriptoria* accepted for the celebration of the **VIII International Conference of Young Contemporary History Researchers**, that will take place in Valladolid on 26, 27 and 28 January 2022.

Likewise, we announce that the deadline for sending communication proposals will be **April 18, 2021**. Their extension will be between 100 and 150 words (in the following links [[Word](#)] or [[PDF](#)] you can find the template for its registration and for its later send. They must be sent to both the Organizing Committee ([joveneshcuva@gmail.com](mailto:joveneshcuva@gmail.com)) as well as to the coordinators of the Workshop and may be written in both Spanish and English. Regarding the participation of the **communicators**, it is agreed that there will be a maximum number of two people for each communication.

All participants whose communication is accepted must send a complete text developed, whose rules and deadline will be specified in future newsletters. Although detailed information on the possible publication of these texts will be made public later, the **Workshop coordinators** will have the responsibility of contacting external reviewers (peer review) to evaluate the communications and thus select, in the most rigorous way, those texts that should be included in the publication (or publications). Ultimately, its final publication will be the decision of the Scientific Committee.

In order to avoid future confusion, those who participate in the VIII Conference must **register** regardless they attend the event or not (in the case of communications co-authored and presented by one of the two authors). A person can coordinate a Workshop or Scriptorium, and later participate, if he/she wish, with a communication at another Workshop. The **maximum number of communications** presented is one per person, that is, the communicators may only be part of one Workshop. All proposals

received will be acknowledged by the Organizing Committee in the shortest period of time.

The deadline for coordinators to communicate to the organization and communicators which proposals are accepted ends on **May 16, 2021**. We remind that each of the Workshop must have a **minimum of 5 communications and a maximum of 20**. In addition, the coordinators of the Workshops will prepare a **dossier** that includes the general lines of the Workshop which serves as a basis for debate.

As for the *Scriptoria*, they can be consulted in the annexed section. Likewise, the coordination will remain in the hands of those responsible for each *Scriptorium*. Their extension will be between 100 and 150 words (in the following links [[Word](#)] or [[PDF](#)] you can find the template for its registration and for its later send. Thus, proposals for participation in them must also be sent to both the Organizing Committee ([joveneshcuva@gmail.com](mailto:joveneshcuva@gmail.com)) as well as to the Scriptoria coordinators and may be written in both Spanish and English. All proposals received will be acknowledged by the Organizing Committee in the shortest period of time, whose deadline for submitting proposals is the same day on April 18, 2021.
